

Concert Clothes Information!!

Remember - concert clothes are to be worn by all members of the band for concert performances. Here are the guidelines (as stated in the band manual):

GUYS:

You must wear a black suit coat, black dress slacks, white dress shirt, black bow tie, black socks, and black dress shoes. If you do not already own these items, you may purchase them from any tuxedo store. A special price is being offered to the Cypress Band, through Tuxedo Court in Cypress. The fitting will take place during 7th period, however, you must go to the store on your own time to complete the purchase and pick up your tuxedo. (A map will be made available) For approximately \$80.00 (plus tax) you will get:

- Black Tuxedo Coat and Black Tuxedo Slacks
- White Tuxedo Shirt
- Black Bow-tie and Black Cummerbund
- Shirt studs and cufflinks

This special does NOT include socks and shoes, but Tuxedo Court will be glad to assist if you would like to purchase these additional items. Currently, the marching band shoes are acceptable as shoes for the concert tuxedo. If you need alterations done as well, they will be happy to assist you.

Please note that you will be paying Tuxedo Court directly, not using Individual Account balances.

LADIES:

You must wear a black, floor-length dress with 3/4 or full-length sleeves. If you do not have a dress that meets this description, you may put together an ensemble that is similar. Please note that slits of any kind will not be permitted and your outfit must be inspected and approved by Mr. Quirion before it is worn at the concert.

A concert dress will be available for purchase through the Boosters. For approximately \$80.00 (\$69.50 plus tax and shipping) you will receive a dress from Simco Formalwear. (For larger sizes \$8.00 will be added.) You will be fitted in the band room sometime in November. *All dress ordered must be paid for in advance, not using Individual Account balances.*

Please note that you are responsible for purchasing your own shoes. They must be black with a heel no higher than two inches.

Concert Clothes are required for our first concert performance on December 15, 2009.
